





Present Scenario of women in India:



January 3 marks the birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule. Known for her contribution in the field of women's education, Savitribai Phule was born on January 3, 1831, in Maharashtra's Satara district in a country ruled by the Britishers, where women rights were non-existent. She is widely regarded as a woman teacher who campaigned to create awareness on the need for education for women. A feminist icon, Phule fought against patriarchy and casteism and faced countless hardships in the process.

Savitribai Phule was born in 1831 in a village called Naigaon in Satara District, Maharashtra. She was the daughter of Lakshmi and Khandoji Nevase Patil, who went on to marry social activist Jyotirao Phule. While the couple had no children of their own, they are said to have adopted Yashawantrao. At that time, she was illiterate and received education from her husband at home. After primary education, she even received higher education, before enrolling herself in two teacher's training programs. It can, therefore, be said that she was India's first woman teacher and also a headmistress. Her birthday is known as 'Balika Din' in Maharashtra, and is celebrated in many girls' schools. Phule was always vocal about inhuman and unjust practices that persecuted women and young girls. She was unafraid to raise her voice against practices like sati and child marriage.

NSS unit of Bajiraoji Karanjekar College of Pharmacy was celebrated on the commemorate birth anniversary of Savitribai Phule on 3rd Jan 2024 to mark her contribution in society, to make women educated and to empower the women's.
